Suppliers who do not comply with the requirements of the Modern Slavery Act Policy will be reminded of DBK AERO LTD's commitment to adherence to the Act and will be asked to fully conform it or shall have their approved supplier status removed.

All employees are being given the DBK AERO LTD's Team Handbook setting out all relevant policies.
